MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

(FOR TEMPORARY VISITORS VISA APPLICATION)

- Passport/Travel Document valid for at least six
 (6) months beyond the intended period of stay in the Philippines
- Duly Accomplished Visa application form;
- Proof of bona fide status as tourist or businessman;
- Confirmed tickets for return or onward journey to the next port of destination.



Chinese nationals

with valid American, Japanese,
Australian, Canadian, Schengen
(AJACS) visa traveling for
tourism or leisure may enter the
Philippines visa-free for a
maximum period of stay of
seven (7) days.

Indian nationals

who have a valid American,

(AJACSSUK) visa/residency traveling
for tourism or leisure may enter the
Philippines visa-free for a maximum
period of stay of fourteen (14) days.

This is NOT applicable for business travelers. Business travelers are required to secure appropriate visas.

Citizens from Taiwan are allowed to obtain an Electronic Travel **Authorization (eTA)** instead of a standard paper visa through the website of the **Manila Economic** and Cultural Office.


Israeli nationals




Holders of Hong Kong (SAR) passports and Macau (SAR) passports are allowed to stay without a visa for fourteen (14) days or less.




CBBU


