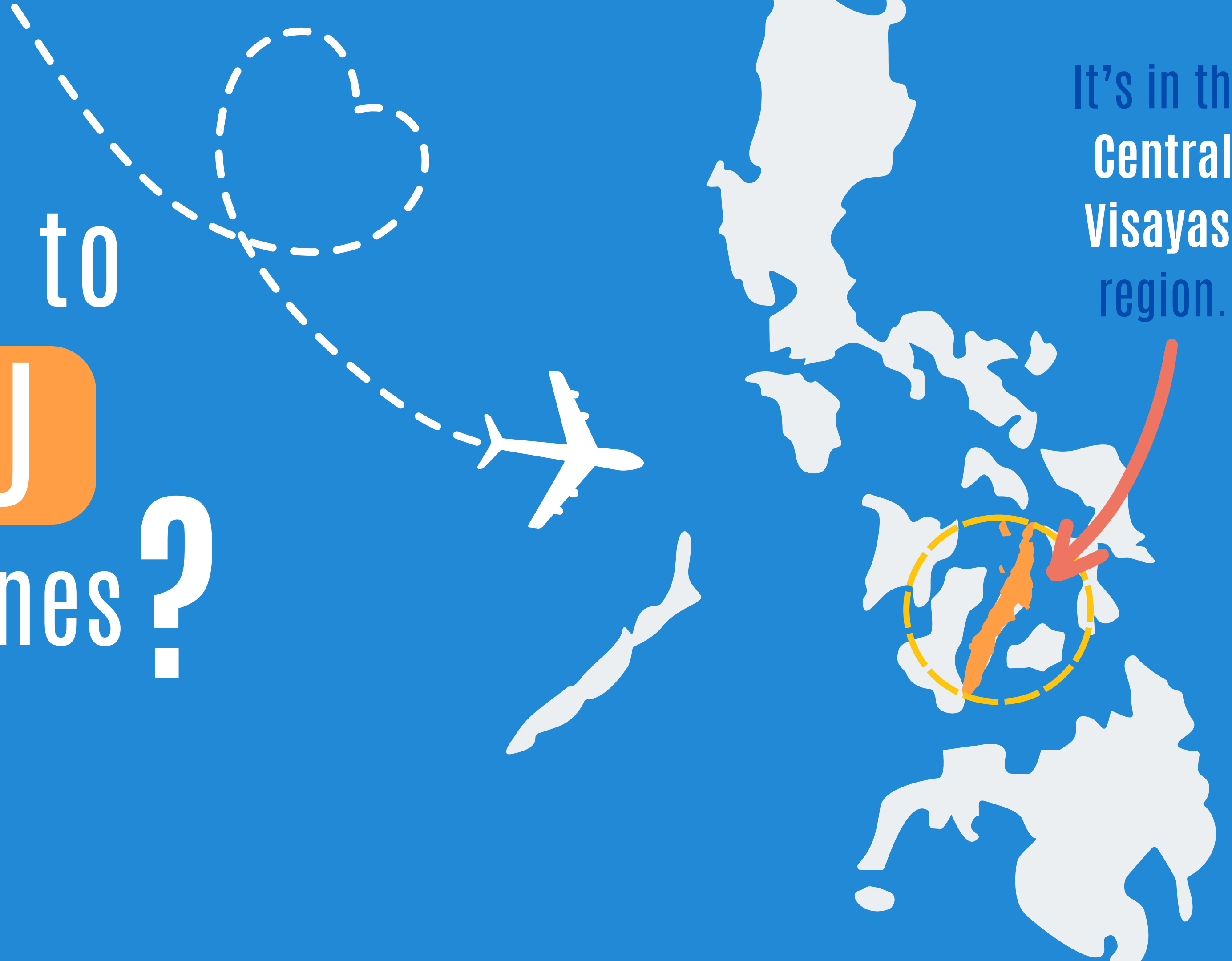

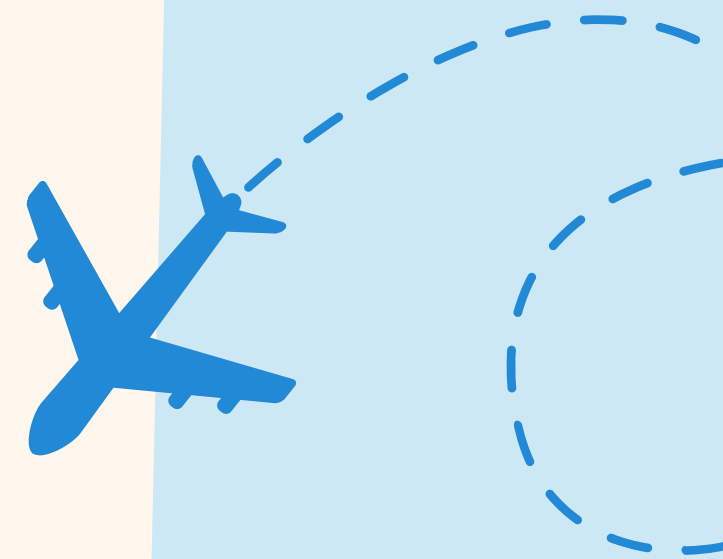

need to apply for a **visa** before traveling to the Philippines.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

(FOR TEMPORARY VISITORS VISA APPLICATION)

- **Passport/Travel Document** valid for at least six (6) months beyond the intended period of stay in the Philippines
- **Duly Accomplished Visa application form;**
- **Proof of bona fide status as tourist or businessman;**
- **Confirmed tickets for return or onward journey to the next port of destination.**

Chinese nationals

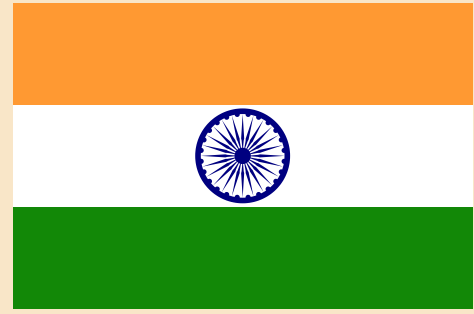
with valid **American, Japanese, Australian, Canadian, Schengen (AJACS) visa** traveling for tourism or leisure may enter the Philippines visa-free for a maximum period of stay of seven (7) days.

This visa-free entry privilege is NOT applicable for business travelers. Business travelers are required to secure appropriate visas.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

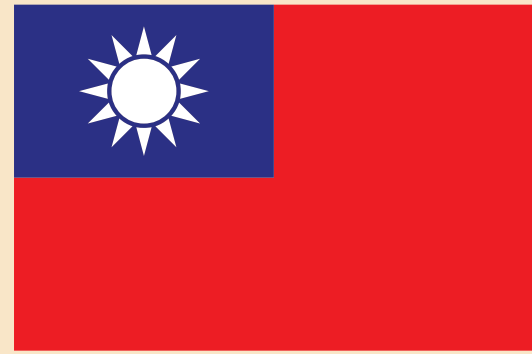
Indian nationals

who have a valid **American, Japanese, Australian, Canadian, Schengen, Singapore or UK (AJACSSUK) visa/residency** traveling for tourism or leisure may enter the Philippines visa-free for a maximum period of stay of fourteen (14) days.

This is NOT applicable for business travelers. Business travelers are required to secure appropriate visas.

Citizens from Taiwan are allowed to obtain an **Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA)** instead of a standard paper visa through the website of the **Manila Economic and Cultural Office**.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- **Passport/Travel Document** valid for at least six (6) months
- **Travel itinerary**
- **Accommodation Information**

Holders of Hong Kong British passports and Macau Portuguese passports are allowed to stay without a visa for **seven (7) days or less.**

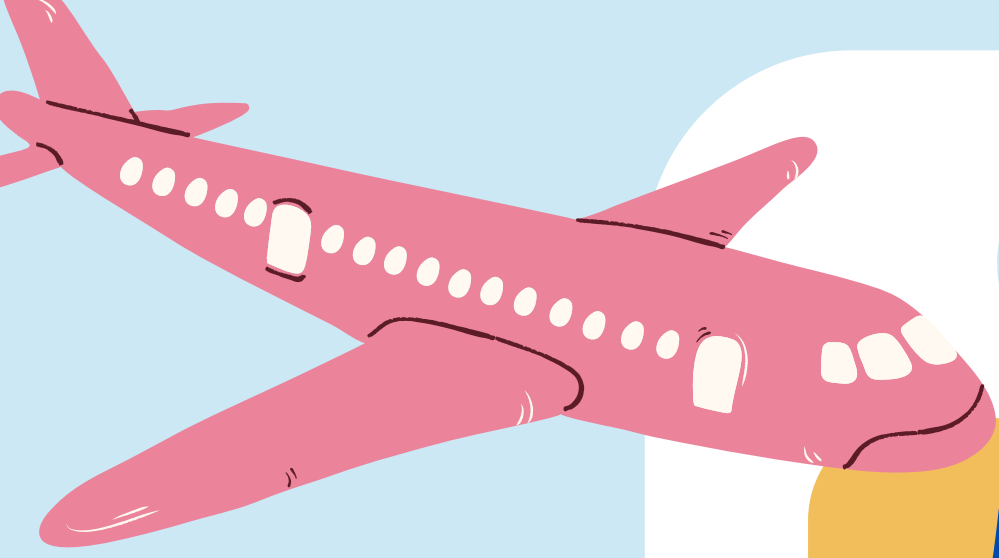

“to walk in the water.”

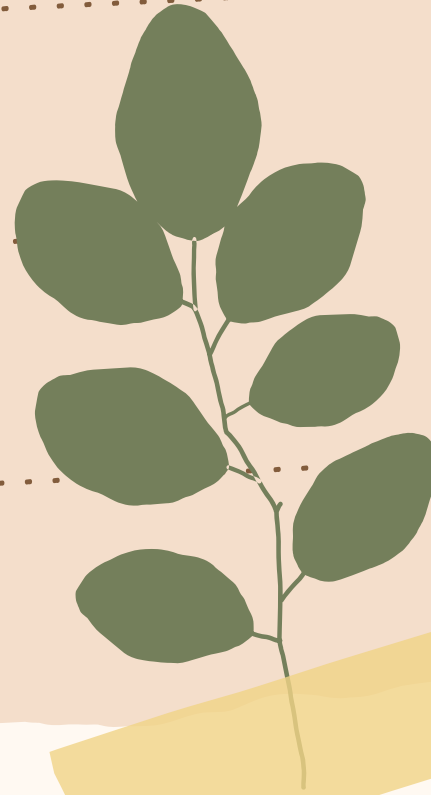
